All configurations can have fixed frames added to the top or sides, or can be coupled together with a corner post, allowing you to reinvent your space and bring your interior design dreams to life.

Fully bespoke, the Origin OI-30 Internal Door is an interior designer's dream, as it can be configured and customised to complement your style and enhance your home's aesthetic.

To develop a full heritage aesthetic, you can choose to add more horizontal and vertical glazing bars.

If you are more inclined towards a minimalist or contemporary design style, you may choose to have fewer glazing bars, allowing for more light to pass through.

The different styles can be further enhanced by your choice of beading – a square bead gives a sharper look which can lend itself to a more edgy looking design, while the chamfered bead emulates the traditional putty line found on traditional steel doors.

Furthermore, ideal for minimising scratches and fingerprints, blackout panels can also be included. Alternatively, kickplates can be added for those times when you need to nudge the door open with your foot if your hands are full.














Architectural variety and heritage...

With its architectural variety and heritage, entrances don't have standard sizes here in the UK. This is why any configuration of door or window that you choose from Origin is precision engineered to the nearest millimetre, according to your custom dimensions. While the main configurations feature single and French doors, the combinations and design opportunities – including the addition of fixed windows – mean there is greater flexibility to create your ideal opening.

Single door

With a maximum door width of 1,000mm and height of 2,500mm, a single door may stand on its own, but it doesn't hold back on letting light through and adding to the flow of your home. These are ideal for brightening up hallways, offices and bathrooms.

French door

Ideal for sectioning off living or dining areas, the French door creates a real statement, whether open or shut. The OI-30 French door's maximum frame width is 2,060mm, but windows can be added to the top and side to add to its magnificence.







Corner configurations

By using a combination of single or French doors, along with a corner post and fixed frames, a corner configuration can be created, which offers even more possibilities to section out areas, even in the most unconventional space.

All Origin Doors can be used in either residential or commercial settings, but here is where a corner configuration really comes into its own. Creating either a breakaway room or central boardroom, they're truly unique in being able to develop an entire new room as big or as small as you require.

Fixed wall, fixed screen or room divider

Perfect for extending the wall of glass look within your home, a fixed frame can be placed above or alongside your door configuration to increase the height or add to the width.

Alternatively, if access isn't required, the OI-30 can be used as a standalone fixed screen.


When you choose an OI-30 Internal Door, the only limit is your imagination.

Choose your preferred configuration using a combination of single doors, French doors and fixed frames and take the first step towards transforming your space.

Working with your chosen Partner, specify your overall size and colour, desired set up, handle type and colour, locking mechanism, preferred beading style, whether you want the doors to open in or out, what style (if any) of splits or glazing bars you want and their frequency, and whether you want any further design or practical features such as kickplates or panels, and if instructed by you, they will direct us to create the design statement that is the Origin Internal Door.

Individual doors can be sized up to 1,000mm wide and up to 2,500mm tall, with the option to go up to 3,000mm in height by coupling a fixed light above, allowing you to really make a design statement.



Configuration options

Whether you would like a single office door or a configuration to suit a larger opening, such as a home gym or playroom, between your chosen Partner and Origin, we can bring your door together, exactly as you need.

Available as a single or French door, each style brings its own benefit.

Single doors are ideal for opening up hallways or delivering light to the office or bathroom. Your chosen installation Partner will also be able to work with you to choose the right glass option, whether it be reeded or frosted glass to offer up privacy on a bathroom door, or a clear glass option to maximise light flooding through a hallway.

French doors create a real statement, whether open or shut, and are perfect for sectioning off living and dining areas.

Using a combination of single or French doors, along with a corner post and fixed frames, an additional room can be created, which works particularly well within commercial environments.

All configurations are able to include fixed frames either next to or above a set of doors to emulate the classic steel aesthetic. Alternatively, they can be used as a standalone option to divide areas out.





Turn and Release in Antique Brass







A private moment...

While most internal doors will simply feature a handle and a latch, there will be those rooms which require a bit more privacy – such as the office, for those online calls that you could do without a family member appearing on the screen with you, or, of course, the bathroom.

In this instance, you're able to specify a turn and release lock as opposed to just a standard latch, enabling you to lock yourself away for a brief moment of calm.

French doors feature manual shootbolts fitted top and bottom, along with a flush finish shootbolt keep to fit into the floor. In order to keep a symmetrical aesthetic, French doors can also be fitted with a handle on each door. One handle operates the lead door while the secondary handle is purely for visual symmetry and does not operate.

The handle is set on a 90mm wide lock block that is a fundamental steel door design feature. The lock block will vary in its height from the ground depending on the number of glazing splits, so be sure to position it appropriately in order to achieve your desired handle height. If required, the lock block can run the full height of the door.

ISO 45001 recognises our commitment to employee safety and reduction in workplace risks to create a better, safer working condition.




We actively encourage our teams across the business to report any observations that they have so that we can continue to improve and ensure that safety at Origin is at the best standard possible, for everyone.

Glass and glazing

The Origin Internal Door Collection is able to accommodate 4mm, 6mm or 6.8mm glazing units. If directed by you, your chosen Partner will be responsible for sourcing the glass, and they should be able to guide you through the process of selecting what's right for you, whether that be clear, frosted or reeded options.

The latter offers the flexibility of light being able to travel through the home whilst concealing perhaps the laundry in the utility room, or offering privacy for a bathroom.
